In the midst of this harsh winter season, more than 100,000 people will travel to Washington, D.C. on Friday, January 22nd, to join the annual March for Life in our nation's capital. This yearly event is a protest against the infamous Roe v. Wade U.S. Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion on demand in the United States in 1973. Our Lady of Grace parish again will send a bus full of parishioners to stand up for the right to life of every human person made in God's image and likeness.

This year, reflecting the national trend at the March in recent years, more than half of our bus will be young people in their teens and twenties, elementary, high school and college students and young adults who have been handed the torch by an older generation of pro-life advocates. These younger people were not even born when abortion was illegal in our country but, in a brave act of conscience, have reasoned for themselves the central importance of the Right-to-Life of every American.

Also, this year the March for Life is especially significant because of the national health care legislation being debated in Congress at this writing. The House version of the bill prohibits federal funding of abortions, protects the conscience of doctors and nurses who do not want to participate in abortions, and preserves the right of institutions like Catholic hospitals that choose not to provide abortions due to ethical and religious reservations. The Senate version of this national health care legislation is wanting in all three of these critical moral areas, as explained by Daniel Cardinal DiNardo, Chairman of the Respect Life Committee of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, and echoed by our own Bishop David A. Zubik. The insert in today's bulletin provides further information about this ongoing national debate.

For those not going on the March for Life, our parish will provide a day of Eucharistic Adoration on Friday, January 22, from 9:30 a.m. - 8:00 p.m. in solidarity with the marches. Rev. Dr. Lawrence Sutton will preside at the closing Holy Hour for Life from 7:00-8:00 p.m. Marie Milburn, Director of Family Life and Adult Catechesis, Lindsay Pfister, OLG School Principal, Andrea Hoover, our new Youth Minister, and I will lead our bus of 55 parishioners in this important peaceful and public protest in our nation's capital. Please pray for an end to abortion in our land.
