On Sunday, February 3, 2008, Most Rev. David A. Zubik, Bishop of Pittsburgh, will come to Our Lady of Grace Parish to celebrate the 11:30 a.m. Mass, to dedicate our new Marian Grotto and to meet our parishioners afterwards at a reception in Keefer Hall. We are honored and delighted that Bishop Zubik has found time in his busy schedule to be with us on this Sunday before the Lenten Season begins. As you can imagine, he has been in great demand these first few months of his episcopacy in Pittsburgh and we are truly blessed that he will be with us for both liturgy and fellowship.

Obviously, the weather in February is unpredictable, so I want to encourage you to pray for the intercession of Our Lady of Grace that we might have mild weather to facilitate the Bishop's blessing of our new Marian Grotto built in the 60th Anniversary Year of our parish. Sunday, February 3, is also the day of the Super Bowl, but with the Pittsburgh Steelers out of the playoffs the early evening kickoff will not interfere with our parish celebration.

Bishop David Zubik has a deep devotion to the Blessed Mother. You may have noted that his episcopal motto is "Nothing is impossible with God," taken from the Gospel account of the Archangel Gabriel's annunciation to Mary that she was chosen to be the mother of God's Son (Luke 1:26-38). What a wonderful opportunity we will have to welcome our new Bishop, share our devotion with him in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary and celebrate our unity in Christ at the Eucharist. I am proud that we have built such a beautiful, prominent and noble grotto to Mary through the hard work and generous support of the parishioners of Our Lady of Grace.
