Afterwards, everyone is invited to Keefer Hall for a reception hosted by the Women's Guild and Christian Mothers and the opportunity to meet our new Bishop. It will be both an honor and a pleasure for us to welcome Bishop David Zubik to Our Lady of Grace Parish.

From the parishioners I've spoken with these past few months, everyone seems to be proud of this beautiful, prominent and noble grotto, in honor of Our Lady of Grace, that we built during the 60th anniversary year of our parish. Through the hard work and generous support of our parishioners, this grotto stands at the center of our property as a testament of devotion to our patroness. Bishop Zubik has a deep devotion to the Blessed Mother, also. His episcopal motto, "Nothing is impossible with God," is taken from the Gospel account of the Archangel Gabriel's annunciation to Mary that she was chosen to be the mother of God's only Son (Luke 1:26-38).

Later this Spring, we will plant flowers in both the large planters and the two small garden plots. At that time, we will also place two bronze plaques honoring those whose labor built the new grotto and whose generosity financed this collaborative parish project. With Bishop Zubik's visit and blessing, we will be poised to begin the Lenten Season on a high spiritual note.
