FISH FRY



This First Sunday of Lent begins with the powerful account of Jesus' temptation in the desert by Satan following Christ's 40 days of prayer and fasting. As we begin our own 40 days of prayer, fasting and alms giving, let us be mindful of our need to deepen our life in Christ this Lenten Season. To that end, last week's bulletin included a Lenten calendar of events to highlight opportunities in the parish to strengthen your preparation for Holy Week. Extra copies of these purple inserts are available on the shelves and tables near the doors of the church, where you will also find free Lenten prayer booklets if you haven't picked one up by now. Friday evenings in Lent will include the Stations of the Cross, the Sacrament of Penance and the traditional Lenten Fish Fry.

Please note the adjustment in the time for the Sacrament of Penance. With the transfer of Fr. Ken Sparks, I need to move the time of Confession to a later slot on Saturdays: 12:00 noon-1:00 p.m. Should I have a 10:00 a.m. funeral on Saturdays, this gives me time to go to the cemetery and get back to church for the start of Confessions at 12:00 noon. Otherwise, it would be impossible for me to pray the Rite of Committal at the cemetery for the bereaved family. Also, note that during Lent Confessions will be heard on Friday evenings from 7:00 p.m.-7:30 p.m. before the Stations of the Cross. We will no longer have Confessions after the Saturday Vigil Mass in Lent.

Fr. Michael Caridi, STL, Pastor of St. Joseph Parish in Coraopolis, begins our five-part Lenten Series on Pope Benedict XVI this Wednesday evening at the 7:00 p.m. Mass. His extended homily will outline the life of Pope Benedict and will serve as the introduction to the series on the Pope's life and work. Fr. Caridi studied in Rome for five years where he earned his license in dogmatic theology. Benedict XVI has been our pope, now, for almost three years and my hope is that this Lenten Series will deepen our knowledge of the teaching and leadership of this Vicar of Christ who will be visiting the United States in April.
