### A Word from the PASTOR



This Wednesday, at the 7:00 p.m. evening Mass, Rev. Roy Conley will be our guest celebrant and homilist for the third week in our Lenten adult enrichment series. Fr. Conley, who lived and served at Our Lady of Grace Parish for a year following his retirement, will speak about "suffering." Fr. Roy has continued to help out at OLG these past several months and will be a welcomed and respected addition to our Lenten series.

Fr. Roy Conley was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Pittsburgh in 1961. In his most recent assignment, he served as pastor of St. Elizabeth of Hungary Parish in Pleasant Hills for 21 years. Before that he was pastor of St. Aloysius Parish in Reserve Township for 10 years. During some of these years, he also served as dean of the northwest deanery. Prior to becoming a pastor, Fr. Conley served as a parochial vicar in a variety of pastoral assignments in the diocese.

While he lived at the rectory with Fr. Ken and I, we benefitted greatly from his experience, wit and fellowship. Our parishioners enjoy his cogent, insightful and pastoral preaching style which always leaves them with a helpful lesson to incorporate into their lives. In addition to this week's Wednesday night Mass and homily, OLG parishioners are accustomed to seeing Fr. Conley as he substitutes for Fr. Ken and I from time to time and hears confessions of our children and parishioners during the Advent and Lenten seasons. As he did last year, Fr. Conley will be the celebrant for our Easter Sunday 'overflow' masses in Keefer Hall at 9:45 a.m. and 11:45 a.m.

Please come Wednesday night for the midway Mass and homily in our 'fire and brimstone' series on Satan, sin, suffering, death and hell.
