Pastor

Our Wednesday evening Lenten series continues to draw a good number of parishioners for worship and teaching for the "fire and brimstone" topics of Satan, sin, suffering, death and hell. Each priest has approached these serious topics with theological insight, wit and pastoral sensitivity. This Wednesday evening's Mass at 7:00 p.m. includes Fr. Joseph Sioli's homily on death.

Fr. Joseph Sioli, C.O., at 35, is one of the youngest priests in the Diocese of Pittsburgh. He completed his M.A. and M. Div. degrees at St. Vincent Seminary in Latrobe, PA. Ordained for the Oratorian Fathers in Oakland, Fr. Sioli will celebrate the 10th anniversary of his ordination this year on Holy Thursday. Following his ordination, Fr. Joe Sioli was assigned for a couple of years as parochial vicar at St. Paul Cathedral. He also served a year at St. Mary Parish in Williamstown, N.J., near his hometown in Southern New Jersey. From 2000-2006, he was chaplain to the college communities at the University of Pittsburgh, Carnegie-Mellon University and Chatham College. He also studied at the Liturgical Institute at Mundelein Seminary in Illinois.

Though the youngest of all the visiting priests we have invited for the series, Fr. Joseph Sioli's homily will explore the importance of a good and holy death for the Christian believer. See you at the 7:00 p.m. Wednesday evening Mass on March 21st.
