From the  
Pastor

The story of Jesus' resurrection from the dead resounds throughout time and space, echoing through history and across the continents to every corner of the world. Today, Christians everywhere rise with their Lord in faith and hope to celebrate Christ's victory over Satan, sin and death. Jesus' resurrection from the dead renews a world dying for God's love and mercy.

Our word 'Easter' points to Christ, as it derives from an Old English root that meant "coming from the east" and, as you know, the sun rises in the eastern sky each morning, suggesting the light of Christ's resurrection from the darkness of death. Both English and German pagans used to celebrate a spring festival whose name was similar to Easter. When these nations became Christian, the feast of Jesus' resurrection supplanted the pagan rites of spring and the sunrise in the east would forever be understood in the English-speaking world as suggesting the rising of the Son of God from the dead. Years ago, churches were always built facing east to greet the rising sun, as well as the Son who rose from the dead, i.e., from the east.

This Easter proclamation fulfills the hunger of the human heart for hope; it gives faith to the soul searching for meaning; and it promises divine love to the person yearning to be with God forever. Alleluia! Alleluia! He is risen from the dead! Alleluia, forevermore!
