From the
Pastor

Our five-part Lenten series on Satan, sin, suffering, death and hell concludes this Wednesday evening with Rev. Daniele Vallecorsa's homily on 'Hell' in the context of Eucharistic Adoration. OLG's Holy Hour will begin at 7:00 p.m. (an hour earlier than usual) on Wednesday, March 28, and conclude at 8:00 p.m. Fr. Vallecorsa's closing talk will touch on the theological underpinnings of Dante's *Divine Comedy*, in particular, the 'Inferno' (Hell) and the author's mysticism. The series has been well-attended and the talks have been eclectic and insightful whether in a lecture, a homily in Mass, or a sermon in the context of adoration.

Rev. Daniele Vallecorsa, STL, has been the Chaplain of the Latino Catholic Community in the Diocese of Pittsburgh for the past three years. He holds bachelor and master's degrees in Italian and Spanish languages and literatures from the University of Pittsburgh. He earned an STL (a license in dogmatic theology) while attending the North American College in Rome, with a specialization in sacramental theology. In preparation for his current assignment, Fr. Vallecorsa spent a summer semester in intensive language and cultural studies in Valencia, Spain and Guadalajara, Mexico.

Fr. Vallecorsa's home parish was Christ the King in Ambridge. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1993 for the Diocese of Pittsburgh. He has also served as a parochial vicar at St. Vincent de Paul Parish in New Castle, St. Thomas More in Bethel Park, and St. Raphael in Pittsburgh's Morningside neighborhood.

Please come to our Holy Hour this Wednesday, March 28, from 7:00-8:00 p.m., to hear Rev. Daniele Vallecorsa conclude our Lenten series with a stirring homily on 'Hell.'
