Pastor

The Second Sunday of Easter, or Divine Mercy Sunday, will be celebrated at Our Lady of Grace with a Holy Hour, Procession with the Blessed Sacrament, Benediction and Veneration of a Relic of St. Faustina Kowalska at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, April 15. Very Rev. Brian Welding, JCD, STL, the Judicial Vicar for the Diocese of Pittsburgh, will preside and preach at this solemn afternoon Holy Hour.

On June 29, 2002, the Apostolic Penitentiary, directed by Pope John Paul II, decreed: "To ensure that the faithful would observe this day with intense devotion, the Supreme Pontiff himself established that this Sunday be enriched by a plenary indulgence so that the faithful might receive in great abundance the gift of the consolation of the Holy Spirit. And so the Supreme Pontiff, motivated by an ardent desire to foster in Christians this devotion to Divine Mercy as much as possible in the hope of offering great spiritual fruit to the faithful, granted the following indulgences:

A plenary indulgence, granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on the Second Sunday of Easter or Divine Mercy Sunday, in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy, or who, in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (e.g. "Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!")

A partial indulgence, granted to the faithful who, at least with a contrite heart, pray to the merciful Lord Jesus a legitimately approved invocation. This Decree has perpetual force, any provision to the contrary notwithstanding."
