With the celebration of Pentecost Sunday today, the Church completes the Easter Season. As you well know, Pentecost Sunday recalls that day when the Holy Spirit of God, in the form of tongues of fire and a rushing wind, anointed the apostles to preach and baptize throughout the world as Jesus had instructed them before His Ascension into heaven. This 'birthday of the Church' is recorded in the Acts of the Apostles by St. Luke, and echoed in St. John's gospel account of Jesus breathing the Spirit on the apostles to spread the good news and forgive sins.

Pentecost, 50 days after Easter Sunday, marks the Church's beginning to share the truth of God's love revealed in Jesus through the preaching of the gospel, the celebration of the sacraments, and the building up of the Body of Christ. It is a good day for us to reflect on the life of our parish church, too, and the many gifts that God has given us to share with each other, the younger generation of Christian believers and the people in our local community.

On Thursday, June 7th, Our Lady of Grace will celebrate the 60th Anniversary of the founding of our parish by Bishop Hugh Boyle. The following year, Fr. Keefer purchased the site for our parish complex. A couple of years later, in 1950, Bishop John Dearden dedicated the first parish building for use as a church and classrooms. The first school building and addition to the original Church was dedicated and opened in 1954. The second addition and new wing to accommodate the growing OLG Catholic School was completed in 1956. A third expansion was necessary by 1958. And the current new Church building and rectory was built between 1962 and 1963, with the dedication by Bishop John Wright on June 12, 1963. The new gymnasium was built in 1995.

While the 60th Anniversary may not be as momentous as the 50th was in 1997, we'll mark the day with prayer and a social gathering in celebration of God's gracious gift of His Holy Spirit to generations of Catholics who know Our Lady of Grace Parish as their community of faith.

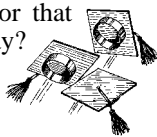
