Today we celebrate Pentecost Sunday, the conclusion of the Easter Season. Ten days after Ascension Thursday and fifty days after Easter, this solemnity marks the birthday of the Church through the descent of the Holy Spirit on the apostles gathered in the Upper Room. Last week, Bishop William Winter came to OLG to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation for our 62 eighth grade students. It was a beautiful celebration with the Church full of people. Now, today, we celebrate the gifts of the Spirit poured out on the apostles at that first Pentecost.

Recently, at Our Lady of Grace, Sr. Grace Marie Herrle, C.S.J., Director of Social Services, galvanized a group of parish organizations to collaborate on a project to help immigrant families. To me, it was a vivid manifestation of the gifts of the Spirit, alive at OLG in the various parish organizations, cooperating for the greater good while maintaining their unique identities. Sr. Grace enlisted the aid of more than eight (8) parish groups to make substantial welcoming baskets of household goods and supplies to give to newly-arrived immigrants to the U.S.A. An initiative of Catholic Charities, OLG's contribution of 45 welcome baskets was more than any other parish in the Diocese. Our various parish groups worked together to make this significant contribution to the life of these vulnerable immigrant families.

Sister Grace was successful in enlisting the help of our Women's Guild and Christian Mothers, the Respect Life Committee, the families of our Religious Education Program (CCD), the Evangelization Committee of the Parish Pastoral Council, the Ladies of Charity, the St. Vincent de Paul Society, the Boy/Girl Scouts, and the Catholic Scripture Study Group. Working together, these individual parish groups cooperated in a project that evidences the power of the Holy Spirit extending from our parish into the larger community.
