Thursday, June 7, 2007 marks the 60th Anniversary of the founding of Our Lady of Grace Parish to serve the Catholic community in Scott Township and the neighboring area. The parish has grown considerably since those post-war years, adding families, programs and buildings to accommodate the healthy expansion and development of parish life. This summer, you'll begin to see new signs of continued development on our grounds, in our buildings and with our parishioners.

Last month, we received diocesan approval for two capital projects: the building of a grotto to our Blessed Mother on the ridge above our field and near the parking lots; and the replacement of the original boilers in our school building. The money for both projects is already on hand, supplied by a combination of fundraising, frugal management of the budget and some generous donations by parish groups and individuals. You'll begin to see signs of both projects in June.

On Thursday evening, June 7th, at 7:00 p.m. we will hold a special Vespers prayer service in Church to mark the 60th Anniversary of Our Lady of Grace Parish. Following Vespers, there will be a social reception in Keefer Hall. Besides light refreshments, you will also have the opportunity to view the plans and materials for the Marian Grotto. Please plan on joining us for this joyful occasion as we celebrate this important date in the history of Our Lady of Grace Parish.
