Over the past few years, in our diocese and across the United States, there has been a noted growth in men's Catholic fellowship groups. These groups have developed on both the parish and diocesan levels, as evidenced by the recent Spring gathering at the Palumbo Center of Duquesne University, at which about 16 men from OLG attended.

Last Fall, Fr. Ken Sparks began an initial parish group on Sunday evenings that drew several interested men of OLG.

While the interest was not sustained into the winter, this initial parish group and the men who attended the diocesan gathering has produced a list of a couple dozen men interested in forming a men's fellowship group at OLG. This group would be more spiritual and less functional than some of the traditional parish groups that attract men.

With this development in mind, OLG will hold three "Summer Mass and Breakfast Meetings" for all interested men in the parish. The order for the three days is as follows:
