**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:** With the close of the school year, a number of summer improvement projects were started this month. Some are readily noticeable, others are not, but all of them are necessary to maintain and upgrade our Church property and facilities. Following is a list of the major projects we're working on this summer:

- 1 - milling and asphaltting the worst section of our parking lot in front of the school, and patching the potholes throughout the property;
- 2 - reusing the old asphalt to build a substantial, access road from the parking lot down to Campbell Field;
- 3 - installing the two handsome bronze plaques on the benches at the Marian Grotto in recognition of those who built and financially supported this project;
- 4 - repairing some water-damaged brick work above the boiler room behind the rectory and Church;
- 5 - weeding, mulching and pruning the beds and shrubberies throughout the property;
- 6 - beginning the wiring of the school rooms to install computers in every classroom;
- 7 - cleaning, painting and restoring all the various signs on our property, and buildings;
- 8 - painting various rooms in our church, school and rectory such as Keefer Hall, the school library and the secretarial offices, kitchen, conference room, living and dining rooms in the rectory;
- 9 - replastering and painting the few water damaged spots in the ceiling of our Church;
- 10 - painting the rectory garage doors and frames;
- 11 - purchasing new office furniture and computers for the rectory and school offices; and
- 12 - completing the repair and upgrade of our Church organ that endured a lightning strike last year.

So, if you notice service trucks, scaffolding, heavy equipment, workmen, volunteers, ladders, delivery trucks or the sound of various power tools on our property this summer, you'll know that we're busy maintaining and upgrading our six buildings and sixteen acres.
