A REFLECTION ON LIFE FOR FATHER'S DAY - On April 18, 2007, the U.S. Supreme Court issued its decision upholding the federal ban of partial birth abortion, which was signed into law more than three years earlier on November 5, 2003. Participating in our parish pilgrimage to Washington, D.C. and southern Maryland, I was greeted on the morning of Thursday, April 19, by the headline of the Washington Post, "Partial-birth abortion ban upheld," announcing the news. What a privilege it was to offer thanksgiving later that day at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception for this landmark victory. I could not help remembering the tears I had shed as a university student upon learning that Congress had fallen just short of the 2/3 majority necessary to overturn President Clinton's veto of a similar ban or the afternoon of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament held here at Our Lady of Grace on Wednesday, November 8, 2006, the day the Court heard the oral arguments for the case which was decided this April. This decision marks "the first time in 34 years that the Court has upheld a ban of any type of abortion... The Court is taking a clearer and more unobstructed look at the tragic reality of abortion, and speaking about that reality more candidly, than it has in many years" (Cardinal Justin Rigali, Archbishop of Philadelphia and Chairman of the U.S. Bishops' Committee for Pro-Life Activities). Let us continue to ask God's mercy for our nation and for all those threatened or harmed by abortion. Let's be signs of hope in a world in great need of the good news about life.
