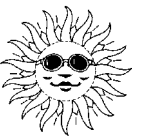

This week, Judith Hill, our Youth Ministry Director, will lead 97 high school students and adults on the annual Appalachian Mission Trip to pray, assist poor families in Tennessee and deepen the bonds of fellowship among our young people. This is, by far, the largest group of teenagers and adults that we have ever taken on this summer apostolic adventure. As in past years, the group includes students and adults from neighboring parishes, as well as our parishioners. Seminarian Dan Gallagher will be with our group for this important youth outreach to lend a prayerful presence as well as to wield a hammer.

Four years ago when I first came to OLG, the mission group was about 37, or so, students and adults. Last year it had doubled to about 67. So, this group represents nearly a tripling of the total of young people and adult chaperons willing to lend a hand to impoverished people in the Appalachian region. The Lord has "blessed the work of our hands" and multiplied it to help more needy people benefit from the skilled home repairs and the joy and hope offered by our young people. As we all know, the driving inspiration of this parish outreach effort is Judith Hill, our Director of Youth Ministry at OLG for more than 20 years. Hers is a labor of love for our students, the poor families they serve and the Lord God to whom goes the glory.

Finally, if we are as fortunate as we were last year, our returning missionaries will be bringing home about 1,000 pounds of delicious Tennessee tomatoes to sell after all masses next weekend to begin fundraising for next year's trip. If you recall, last year they sold out before the 11:30 a.m. Mass.

Lunch is at the work site of sandwiches from the cooler. We will put on ramps from trailers for a woman with MS and Missy, her twelve year old daughter, drywall, repair plumbing, install a water heater, repair or replace a tin roof, scrape, patch, caulk, prime and paint exterior siding, repair rotted wooden floor on a front porch, etc. One year we built a back porch which became the only place large enough for the entire family to eat together at the same time. This year we will divide a room into two so there will be two bedrooms in an already small home. Missy is a member of her youth group and she told me on the phone that the first of each month they get to go to Hardee's and it is really fun. They went on a retreat and the home she got to stay in "had a swimming pool and it even had water in it." We will have many more experiences to share when we return to our OLG family.
