Last week, we concluded the Year of St. Paul in the Church as suggested by Pope Benedict XVI. We had several devotional and catechetical opportunities to pray about and study the life and writings of St. Paul in the New Testament, including the Bible Timeline Course that concludes this Thursday, July 9th, with the last of eight sessions in Keefer Hall on Jesus and the early Church. As we finish this adult education series, we will be offering another catechetical program this week designed for younger parishioners.

The annual OLG Vacation Bible School is scheduled for this week, July 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon in our school building. This week-long summer course for primary grade children also includes high school students volunteering for service hours. Designed by parishioner Pam Tracy, this year's focus is on the 5 Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary: the Resurrection of Jesus, his Ascension, the Descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles, the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the Crowning of Mary Queen of Heaven.

This year will complete the four-year cycle on the Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful and Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary that have formed the Catholic curriculum for our Vacation Bible School. This original material created by Pam Tracy is unique to the VBS offered at Our Lady of Grace Parish and has a strong Catholic character in its lessons. As we complete the Year of St. Paul, you may want to enlist your young children in this valuable program that will deepen their knowledge of the gospel stories and their devotion for Mary, the Mother of God.
