This Sunday, July 12th, following the 11:30 a.m. Mass, we will have a farewell reception in Keefer Hall for seminarian Daniel Gallagher. Dan has been with us the past two summers while he was completing his Masters Degree in Philosophy at Duquesne University with formation at St. Paul Seminary near Carnegie. Three years ago, Dan graduated from Wheeling-Jesuit University in West Virginia and was thinking of medical school. But following a year of mission work in Jamaica, he responded to God's call and entered St. Paul Seminary for two years of pre-theology studies, including the Masters Degree in Philosophy at Duquesne.

Recently, Dan and I caught up with our Youth Ministry Group in Jefferson City, Tennessee, where 50 of our young people and about a dozen adults worked with Appalachian Outreach to fix roofs, build porches, put in new floors and bathrooms, paint homes, dig French drains, etc., in a concerted effort to help people in need. Dan was with the group last summer, also, as he got involved in various programs at Our Lady of Grace. This summer he also taught "The Quick Journey through the Bible" course for the first few weeks. Last summer he was also involved with our Vacation Bible School. Besides reading, serving or assisting with the distribution of communion at daily Mass, Dan also led communion services last summer at nearby Vanadium Woods. Over the two summers at OLG, Dan did a variety of liturgical, catechetical, pastoral and social activities that broadened his familiarity with parish life.

Next Sunday, Dan leaves for Rome where he will live and study for the next five years at the North American College and the Gregorian University. Our prayers are with him as he follows God's call to the priesthood of Jesus Christ.
