This Wednesday morning, July 25th, we will hold the second of the three-part OLG Men's Group Summer Mass and Breakfast Meetings on "The Heroic Ideal" in the ancient world. This men's gathering will consider the poet Virgil's Roman epic, the Aeneid, with a focus upon Aeneas as the embodiment of the virtuous hero. You need not have a familiarity with classical literature to appreciate my brief presentation and the following discussion.

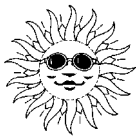
