We were ordained to the priesthood of Jesus Christ about 17 years ago and get together every year to renew the fraternal friendship formed during our years of theological study and priestly formation by the Benedictine monks who taught us at Latrobe, PA. I look forward to this reunion for a couple of days each summer.

I was especially happy to host this year's reunion during the Year of the Priest as designated by Pope Benedict XVI. There were 8 of us who were ordained in 1992 but two have left the priesthood and were laicized by the Church. Of course, I studied for the Diocese of Pittsburgh, two are priests in the Diocese of Greensburg, another is a pastor in the Diocese of Harrisburg, one is in the Diocese of Steubenville, Ohio, and a final classmate is a monk at St Vincent Archabbey. We enjoy getting together for a couple days of meals, camaraderie, prayer, support and talking about our ministries. We tell some stories from our days in the seminary and always enjoy a good laugh together.

Also, after a couple of days here at Our Lady of Grace, we went back to St. Vincent's for the annual Priests' Day hosted by the Benedictine monks who have been training priests for more than 165 years at Latrobe. St. Vincent Archabbey is one of the largest monasteries in the world with about 175 monks.

In this Year of the Priest, I ask for your continued prayers for me, my classmates and friends and for all priests as we strive to serve the people of God in the Church.

MESSAGE FROM POPE BENEDICT XVI TO YOUNG CATHOLICS—The following is an excerpt from Pope Benedict's message to young Catholics given March 6, 2009: "Make space for prayer in your lives! There are many ways to become acquainted with Him. There are experiences, groups and movements, encounters and courses in which to learn to pray and thus grow in the experience of faith. As you know, the summit and centre of the life and mission of every believer and every Christian community is the Eucharist, the sacrament of salvation in which Christ becomes present and gives His Body and Blood as spiritual food for eternal life.
