As we gather this week for our annual parish festival, we will also have the opportunity to welcome our new school principal, Ms. Lindsay Pfister. Ms. Pfister is a young and energetic principal, with excellent credentials and solid teaching experience in Catholic schools. As you may know, our former principal, Mr. Joseph Covelli, had to resign due to recent health concerns and hospitalizations. Our prayers are with Mr. Covelli and his family at this time.

For the past few years, Ms. Pfister worked as a teacher, administrative intern and technology coordinator at St. Gabriel of the Sorrowful Virgin Catholic School in nearby Whitehall. In addition to teaching computer science and religion, her duties at St. Gabriel included serving as acting assistant principal and helping the principal in various administrative tasks such as the completion of diocesan and state forms, ordering textbooks, working with new teachers and assisting with writing assessments, standardized testing and Middle States Annual Reporting. As the Technology Coordinator across the curriculum, Ms. Pfister designed and presented faculty workshops, developed and implemented a school technology plan, and wrote grant proposals.

Ms. Pfister's academic credentials are very impressive. She earned a Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education at Duquesne University, graduating Summa Cum Laude with a Dean's Teaching Fellowship. She also holds two Master of Science degrees in Education from Duquesne, one in Administration and Supervision and the other in Instructional Technology. Her unique educational combination of school administration and instructional technology insures that the students at OLG will continue to benefit from the latest in technological instruction integrated across the curriculum in grades K-8.
