The 2007-2008 academic year begins for Our Lady of Grace School on Monday, August 27th. All of the students, teachers, families, administration and staff are anxiously anticipating this new year. As our carefree summer months come to a close, we turn to the purposeful work of Catholic education: forming the minds, hearts and souls of the young people entrusted to our care.

The 2007-2008 school year will be a year of transition at OLG. With the resignation due to illness of our former principal, Mr. Joseph Covelli, and the departure of two full-time faculty and two part-time teachers, we welcome some new faces to our school. Ms. Lindsay Pfister is our new principal. Ms. Pfister brings excellent academic and professional credentials to her leadership position in our school. Besides her Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education, Summa Cum Laude, she has also earned two Master of Science in Education degrees from Duquesne University, one in Administration and Supervision and the other in Instructional Technology. She has solid teaching experience in Catholic schools, including the past several years as a computer science teacher in grades K-8, technology coordinator for the implementation of computer technology across the curriculum and in-service training of faculty to help them integrate technology in the classroom. Ms. Pfister also brings a focused energy and strong commitment to Catholic education with her considerable academic and professional credentials.

Our stable core of teachers will be joined by new faculty members. Albert Kish, a recent graduate of California State University, with a concentration in Social Studies, will teach Social Studies in grades 5-8. Daniela Pietropaolo, an alumnus of OLG and Robert Morris University, whose degree in education includes a concentration in science, will teach Science in grades 5-8; Virginia Kotok, a veteran teacher will teach Language Arts in grades 4, 5, and 7; and Holly Stehura, a substitute last year and OLG alumnus, will join the faculty as a part-time 4th grade math and social studies teacher, coordinator of the before and after school programs, and work as a floating teacher's aide.

The new school boilers are being installed and the Marian Grotto should be completed in time for our children to visit for October opportunities of prayer.
